Those students who go above and beyond an excellent day earn the ultimate reward of achieving "Super Sleuth" status. Students may move up and down the chart throughout the day as needed. Conduct is recorded daily and reported as a weekly average in Tuesday's graded papers.

Our classroom enforces kindness towards others. Based on Carol McCloud's book, *Have You Filled A Bucket Today?*, students fill classmates' buckets throughout the school year when positive character traits and kindness are displayed.
